

Student-led clubs that aim to engage in sustainable development

There are 101 student clubs, including recreational, academic, departmental, athletic, service, social, self-governing, and volunteer clubs.

There are many types of clubs, both active and passive, which are suitable for students to participate in freely according to their own interests, regardless of their academic departments, grades, and genders. Students are encouraged to actively participate in these clubs after school, and to go out and promote the Ministry of Education's project to promote the development of primary and secondary school clubs and social service activities, in order to cultivate the spirit of public welfare and service to the community among the students.

A. Service Activities of the Elementary and Secondary School Community Development Programme

Encourage clubs to co-operate with local primary and secondary schools to create a diversified learning environment on campus and to promote the development of students' social education and interests. A total of 13 to 15 clubs provide services to Heping Elementary School in Keelung, Zhengbin Elementary School in Keelung, Zhongxiao Elementary School in Keelung, Badou Elementary School in Keelung, Shenao Elementary School in Keelung, Sun Yat-sen High School in Keelung, Erxin Junior High School in Keelung, Keelung Girls' High School in Keelung, Haiyang University Middle School in Haiyang, Xiu-feng Elementary School in New Taipei City, Ruifang Elementary School in New Taipei City, and provide services in the areas of music, orchestral music, guitar, piano, comics, astronomy, archery, football, and other areas of interest to students.

B. Summer and winter camp services for primary and secondary school students in the Education Priority Area

Combining the professional characteristics of the department and service clubs, we actively participate in public service activities and promote young people to use their expertise and knowledge skills to deeply cultivate service areas through volunteer service, cultivate diversified values of life, inspire care for the humanities and the ecological environment through topics such as life education, gender equality, marine education, environmental protection, and character education, and promote social coexistence in order to implement the social responsibility of the university.

本校設有多元學生社團，如康樂性、學術性、學系性、體育性、服務性、聯誼性、自治性及志工群等社團，共計 **101** 個社團。

社團類型眾多，動靜皆宜，適合本校同學依照自己之興趣自由參加，不受就讀之科系、年級、性別之限制，鼓勵同學利用課餘時間踴躍參與，更藉由社團之參與走出戶外，並推動教育部帶動中小學社團發展計畫及社會服務等活動，以培養學生熱心公益及服務社群之精神。

一、帶動中小學社團發展計畫服務活動

鼓勵社團發揮社團特色及專長與在地中小學合作，營造校園多元學習環境，促進學生群育發展及興趣之培養。每年度安排至少 **8** 次之服務，共有 **13~15** 個社團進行服務，分別前往基隆市和平國小、基隆市正濱國小、基隆市忠孝國小、基隆市八斗國小、基隆市深澳國小、基隆市中山高中、二信中學、基隆女中、海大附中、新北市秀峰國小及新北市瑞芳國中提供國樂、管弦、吉他、鋼琴、動漫畫、天文觀測、射箭、足球、銳劍、海洋生態、辯論、主持及自然環境生態等服務

二、教育優先區中小學生寒暑假營隊服務

結合系所專業特色與服務性社團，積極參與公益服務活動，推動青年以志願服務方式，運用專長與知識技能深耕服務場域，以生命教育、性別平等、海洋教育、環境保護及品德教育等議題培養生命多元價值觀、啟發人文與生態環境之關懷，促進社會共好，落實大學社會責任。
